Fort Myers Business Owner Receives National Award ***Dr. Jennifer Languell Named NAHB Green Advocate of the Year***

Fort Myers, FL (May 31, 2011) – Dr. Jennifer Languell, president and owner of Fort Myers-based Trifecta Construction Solutions, has been named the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB) 2011 Green Advocate of the Year. She becomes the first person to win the individual advocacy award twice since its inception in 1997. The award was presented at the National Green Building Conference in Salt Lake City, Utah.

Languell, one of the leading green building consultants in the Southeastern United States, received the award for her work in educating the home building industry, consumers, commercial builders, government officials, and other groups about the benefits of building in a more sustainable manner.
